

THE SYNAXARION

On January 12th in the Holy Orthodox Church, we continue to celebrate the Theophany (Epiphany) of our Lord Jesus Christ, and we commemorate the holy Martyr Tatiana of Rome, the Deaconess, and those with her.

For Tatiana, who was in all things resplendent, The bright sword gave her head a resplendent laurel. On the twelfth, they trimmed Tatiana's neck.

Tatiana lived during the reign of Emperor Alexander Severus, whose chief assistants persecuted Christians without the emperor's orders. When they brought out the virgin Tatiana for torture, she prayed to God for her torturers. And behold, their eyes were opened and they saw four angels around the martyr. Seeing this, eight of them believed in Christ for which they also were tortured and slain. The tormentors continued to disfigure Tatiana, but God sent His angels to the dungeon to encourage her and to heal her wounds. Each morning, Tatiana appeared before the torturers completely healed. Finally, Tatiana and her father were both beheaded in about the year 225. Thus, this heroic woman and those with her were crowned with immortal wreaths of glory.

On this day, we also commemorate Martyr Peter Absalom of Palestine. By the intercessions of Thy saints, O Christ God, have mercy upon us. Amen.

The Reading from the Epistle of Saint Paul to the Ephesians (4:7-13)

Brethren, grace was given to each of us according to the measure of Christ's gift. Therefore, it is said, "When He ascended on high He led a host of captives, and He gave gifts to men." (In saying, "He ascended," what does it mean but that He had also descended into the lower parts of the earth? He who descended is He who also ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.) And His gifts were that some should be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.



Baptizing the World, Part One

Until the fourth century, the Christian Church continued to celebrate one feast, for the birth of Christ and his baptism together. The feast marked one occasion to celebrate two divine events. However, after the Byzantine emperor, Constantine the Great, converted to Christianity followed by many others, starting in the fourth century, their new religious practices started to become mixed with the pagan customs and ceremonies previously ingrained in their conscience, which conflicted with their new faith. This forced the Church to confront and overcome the new challenge by Christianizing it.

The feast of the sun god was a great feast in the Roman Empire, especially in the East. Feasts are always, unfortunately, occasions to escape morality for many. When new believers continued to celebrate this feast alongside the Christian feasts, the Church, the pillar of truth, decided to separate Christmas from Theophany and assign a special feast for it – independent feasts for the Lord's birth and baptism. The feast of baptism remained on January 6, and Christmas was moved to December 25, the date of the feast of the sun.

Therefore, those who attend the prayers and liturgical services will notice an almost complete similarity in the structure of the two festal services.

The Christmas apolytikion uses the title "Sun of Justice" for Christ: "For they that worshipped the stars learned through a star (the light of the knowledge of Christ) to worship Thee, O Sun of Justice." Thus, in time, the pagan festival became Christianized, and Christians began to celebrate in a manner befitting their faith.

This is what we call the Christianization, or baptism, of the world. It consists of adopting an existing practice and giving it a Christian meaning. Let us take baptism as a second example. Water in ancient civilization was a source of fear and danger. Ancient man did not have the ability to confront floods, torrents, heavy rains and their aftermath, let alone seas and rivers. Water was considered a source of uncontrollable chaos, and was called, in the Old Testament, "chaos." The god of water was a fearsome god. However, water was also considered a sign of purification and cleanliness, and a tangible proof of the inner purity towards which the repentant person turns. Therefore, it was used in most religions as a symbol of purification and inner cleanliness.

St. John the Baptist called for the baptism of repentance, which was a sign of a change in the baptized person's behavior and taking a new path, well pleasing to God and in accordance with the divine commandments. Would the Baptist have called for this water baptism if this practice was unknown and unfamiliar to his contemporaries? Christ came and accepted John's baptism, to teach us "to fulfill all righteousness" (Matthew 3:15). He also asked his disciples to baptize those to whom they preached in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit (Matthew 28:19).

Baptism by water was no longer a mere sign, but became, in Christ, a spiritual rebirth, divine sonship for the baptized, forgiveness of sins, a garment of incorruption, etc. It was no longer a symbol or image of a deeper meaning, but a real act bearing divine grace. In other words, Christianity adopted a familiar practice, gave it a completely new meaning, and arranged a special ritual for its completion, commensurate with the faith.

The same is true for many other things.

Some people try to ridicule Christianity on the grounds that it adopted rituals and practices that existed long before it, and therefore are not of its own invention. Their argument is that the rituals were taken from what came before Christianity – as if the authenticity of a subject lies only in its invention!

دعا القدّيس يوحنّا المعمدان إلى معمودية التوبة، التي كانت علامة على تغيير في سلوك المعتمد، وإشارة إلى انتهاجه طريقاً جديداً، بما يرضي الله ويتناسب مع الوصايا الإلهيّة. هل كان المعمدان ليدعو إلى معموديّة الماء هذه لو كانت هذه الممارسة غير معروفة وغير مألوفة عند معاصريه؟ جاء المسيح واقتبل معموديّة يوحنّا، ليعلّمنا "أن نتم كلّ برّ" (مي ١٥/١). وطلب من تلاميذه أن يعمّدوا الذين يبشرّونهم باسم الآب والابن والروح القدس (مي ٢٧/١).

لم تبق المعمودية بالماء مجرّد علامة، بل صارت، في المسيح، ولادةً روحيّة جديدة، بنوّة إلهيّة للمعتمد، غفراناً للخطايا، لبوساً لعدم الفساد، إلخ. لم تعد رمزاً أو صورة لمدلول أعمق، بل فعلاً حقيقيّاً يحمل نعماً إلهيّة. بكلام آخر، تبنّت المسيحيّة ممارسة مألوفة، وأعطتها مضموناً جديداً بالكليّة، وربّبت طقساً خاصًاً لإتمامها، بما يتناسب والمضمون الإيماني الجديد.

وكذلك الأمر في أمور عديدة أخرى.

يحاول بعضهم التشكيك بالمسيحيّة بحجّة تبنّيها طقوساً وممارسات، موجودة قبلها، وتالياً، ليست من اختراعها. حجّتهم في ذلك أنّها أخذت عما قبلها. وكأنّ أصالة الأمر باختراعه فقط!

تعميد العالم، الجزء الأول

المتروبوليت سابا (اسبر)

بقيت الكنيسة المسيحية تعيّد عيداً واحداً، لميلاد المسيح ولمعموديته سوياً، حقّ القرن الرابع. فكان العيد مناسبة واحدة للاحتفال بالحدثين الإلهيين. لكن بعد اعتناق الامبراطور قسطنطين الكبير للمسيحيّة، ودخول الرعايا فيها، بأعداد غفيرة، بدءاً من القرن الرابع الميلادي، بدأ الخلط بين متطلّبات الدين الجديد والعادات والاحتفالات الوثنية المترسبة في الوجدان، ولو تنافت مع الإيمان الجديد. ما اضطر الكنيسة إلى مواجهة التحدّي الجديد، والتغلب عليه بمسحنته.

كان عيد الإله الشمس عيداً عظيماً في الامبراطورية الرومانية، في الشرق بخاصة. والأعياد، دائماً، وللأسف، مناسبات، عند الكثيرين، للتفلّت الأخلاق. ولمّا بقي المؤمنون الجدد يحتفلون بهذا العيد إلى جانب الأعياد المسيحيّة، ارتأت الكنيسة، عمود الحقّ، أن تفصل الميلاد عن الظهور الإلهي، وتعيّن له عيداً خاصاً به. فجعلت لكلاً من حدثي ميلاد الربّ واعتماده عيداً مستقلاً. بقي التعييد للمعموديّة في السادس كانون الثاني، ونقل عيد الميلاد إلى الخامس والعشرين من كانون الأول، وهو تاريخ

This is to inform you the 2025 Annual General Assembly Meeting for the voting membership of Saint George Antiochian Orthodox Church will be held on <u>Sunday, January 19, 2025</u>, following the Divine Liturgy. <u>The agenda is enclosed on the reverse side of this letter.</u>

To be recognized as a voting member of Saint George Church, a parishioner must be at least eighteen years of age and have fulfilled both the necessary spiritual obligations (as determined by the Pastor) and the financial obligations (as determined by the Financial Secretary), which require a minimum contribution of \$600 per married couple or \$300 per individual received between January 1, 2024, and December 31, 2024. Each married couple attending the meeting will be given two ballots — one for each spouse in attendance — while individual members, over the age of 18, who have met the requirements, will each receive one ballot from the Financial Secretary at the meeting. Only those present at the meeting may vote; no proxy votes are permitted. If you have not already met your financial obligation, please do so before December 31, 2024. If you are experiencing financial hardship, please see the Pastor. Should you have any further questions regarding these requirements, please contact a member of the Parish Council.

The goal of Saint George Antiochian Orthodox Church is to have all eligible members vote.

At this General Assembly, elections will be held for four (4) seats for a three-year term on the Parish Council. A Nominating Committee has been appointed to compile a list of qualified candidates. The members of the committee are Fr. Fouad Saba, Fr. Gabriel Coronel, Dn. George Nassief, Mr. Elias Akkari, and Mr. Steve Saba. If you or someone you know is interested in running for the Parish Council and is willing to make the commitment required to fulfill this important obligation, please contact the Nominating Committee.

It is important to note that pursuant to the Saint George Church Constitution, <u>no nominations will be accepted from the floor during the Annual General Assembly Meeting</u>. All candidates' names must be submitted to the Nominating Committee by Wednesday, January 8, 2025, in order for the candidate's name to be included on the Ballot. <u>There can be no exception to this rule</u>.

During this General Assembly Meeting, all members will also receive a full 2024 Financial Report, the proposed 2025 Annual Budget, and reports from the various organizations and hear about all current plans for the coming year. 2024 was an extremely active year in the life of Saint George Church and your attendance will add greatly to the discussion.

The Church is our spiritual home. Your involvement in the affairs of your Church is very important. May God bless you all as we prepare for the birth of the Savior!







The following should be prepared for the Home Blessing:

- All members of family must be present
- Bible
- Icon

- Lit Candle
- Burning Incense (Optional)
- Small Table (or dining room table)

The visit by Father Saba or Father Gabriel should be approximately **45 minutes**. Several visits will be scheduled on a given day in order to reach and bless all families and homes this season.

Once the Home Blessing Season is mostly over, Father Saba and Father Gabriel will continue regular Pastoral Visits, during which Father Saba or Father Gabriel will spend ample time with each family.
