





ACCORDING TO TRADITION, AFTER THE CRUCIFIXION AND RESURRECTION OF CHRIST, SAINT MARY MAGDALENE WAS BROUGHT IN FRONT OF THE EMPEROR OF ROME IN THE PRESENCE OF A LARGE CROWD, ST. MARY BEGAN TALKING TO CAESAR ABOUT THE RESURRECTION OF CHRIST. SHE PICKED UP AN EGG FROM THE NNER TABLE TO ILLUSTRATE HER POINT ABOUT THE RESURRECTION, CAESAR WAS NOT CONVINCED AND REPLIED: "THERE IS CHANCE OF A HUMAN RETURNING TO LIFE AS MUCH AS THERE IS A CHANCE FOR THE EGG THAT YOU HOLD TO TURN RED" IMMEDIATELY, THE EGG MIRACULOUSLY TURNED RED IN HER HAND! IT IS BECAUSE OF THIS TRADITION THAT ORTHODOX CHRISTIANS EXCHANGE RED EGGS AT EASTER.
